With the support of United Way, Alice went from dreaming to save to saving for future dreams

Alice is a mother of two young children who dreams of saving for their college education. She works as a nurse's assistant and earns a little more than \$11,000 annually. Since she doesn't earn a lot of money, Alice is not able to save for her children's college education as she would like. She went to a library in her community to participate in the Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA) program, an IRS-supported tax preparation service through which trained volunteers prepare taxes at no cost for qualifying individuals and families. At the library, Alice had her taxes prepared by a representative of a United Way funded partner agency and learned that she was eligible for valuable tax credits. To her surprise, she received a refund of nearly double the amount she expected. Alice decided to purchase a \$500 savings bond for each of her children, making the dream of investing in their education a reality.
