Charles graduated from Kingsway in 2009. His mixed emotions about graduating stemmed from both being proud of his accomplishments and being sad because it was time for him to leave Kingsway. But he wasn't leaving unprepared. The Community Based Instruction program prepared him for the transition to life after Kingsway. He received invaluable workplace training, such as what to expect from an employer and how to utilize public transportation.

Charles' proudest accomplishment? Without a doubt being hired at Kingsway in 2013. Charles recalls the moment he received the call that he would be hired as a 1:1 aide and smiles at the memory. Kingsway has had a monumental impact on Charles' life. The caring nature of Kingsway helped him become the person he is today in so many ways and Charles brings the heart of Kingsway into the community no matter where he goes.
